<u>Drink of the week – Well, it's almost Valentine's Day</u> and whether you celebrate it or not, let's have some drinks! This is called a Jack Rose, and its origin comes from the base ingredient Laird's Applejack, an apple brandy made in New Jersey and the drinks rosy color. For dramatic effect, let's say it's named after Jack and Rose from The Titanic and their love affair. That sounds better to me. This drink was also included in the novel The Sun Also Rises by Hemingway and a favorite of his.

Ok, here we go –

- 1 1/2 ounces applejack or apple brandy
- 3/4 ounce lemon juice, freshly squeezed
- 1/2 ounce grenadine
- Garnish: apple slices

Two simple steps –

- 1. Add the applejack, lemon juice and grenadine into a shaker with ice and shake until well-chilled.
- 2. Fine strain into a coupe glass and garnish with apple slices




